Resident's Testimony: Ng Siang Hai

Hi everyone, may God bless you. My name is Ah Hai, I thank God for saving me and giving me this opportunity to share my testimony. I'm 35 years old, I started my nonsense at the age of 12. I did not like going to school, I 'ponteng' a lot and dropped out of school in Primary 6. I started smoking and gaming and I got into glue sniffing at 13.

When I had a rental flat in Bukit Merah, I would pick up junk from around the neighbourhood and bring them home. Some things were useful for me, but most I just kept in the house. Suddenly, one day the flat was full. I couldn't find space to sleep. My family helped to clear a few times, HDB town council came twice, and the Hiding Place came once to move everything out. I brought a big headache to my family, especially my mother.

For my glue addiction, I was charged three times and sent to prison rehab, and I was admitted five times to IMH detox programme. The psychiatrist said that my brain has been affected by glue sniffing. Stealing landed me in prison three times. I received a final warning from the police that if I was caught stealing again, I would face a long-term imprisonment.

All these things did not affect me. I was very stubborn; I did not listen to my mum's pleas to get help. All my mum could do was pray very hard to God to change my thinking. Twice my mum brought me to Hiding Place to seek help, but I was not willing to be admitted. At the second interview, the staff challenged me to voluntarily join the one-year programme if I went back to my old ways again. In less than a year, I was back to my nonsense and glue sniffing again. My mum was seriously angry. She admitted me to IMH for detox and took away the keys to my rental flat. She told me there was only one way out for me - call Hiding Place, or I would become a homeless person.

I respect and love my mum very much. I was desperate, so I called the Hiding Place, ready to be admitted. I thank God the Hiding Place took me in, and gave me a roof over my head. I received Jesus as my personal Lord and Saviour through a bible teacher after a few months.

The staff are nice and really good to me. I thank God for their support and love for me. I have found peace in God's family now and I can bring a smile to my
